PASTORAL CARE


Clergy and the lay pastoral visitor team provide pastoral care to the sick, the isolated, the dying, and the grieving.

OUTREACH


Programs help support those in transitional housing, recent immigrants, and the hungry in our neighbourhood through the Churches on-the-Hill Food Bank.




